

Pre-Industrial Design Application Procedure

Notes to all Applicants

Filling out an application to Brigham Young University is not the same as applying to the Industrial Design Program: **they are two separate applications**. Admittance to the Industrial Design Program is *contingent upon a student being admitted to the university*.

All courses within the Industrial Design Program are limited-enrollment courses requiring departmental approval before registering.

Procedure

- I. **The Pre-Industrial Design application** can be found on the following pages. Please submit this application to **250 SNLB**. It must be received **no later than 4:00 p.m. on August 1st**. This packet is the only application requirement, but priority will be given to those registered as Pre-Industrial Design majors. To declare the major, go to 242 CB or call 801-422-4325.
- II. Upon completion of this application, compile all of your content and turn it in to 250 SNLB in person or via mail, email, or fax. If mailing, send this documentation to:

We also recommend using a traceable delivery method to ensure its safe and timely arrival.

Applications will not be returned to the applicant. We will only accept complete applications.

- III. After the applications have been received, a notification e-mail will be sent to each applicant by August 8th indicating to which semester (fall or winter) he/she has been assigned. (Incoming students will be split between the two semesters.) Upon receiving this e-mail, the applicant will be able to register for the Industrial Design Foundation Courses for the applicable semester.

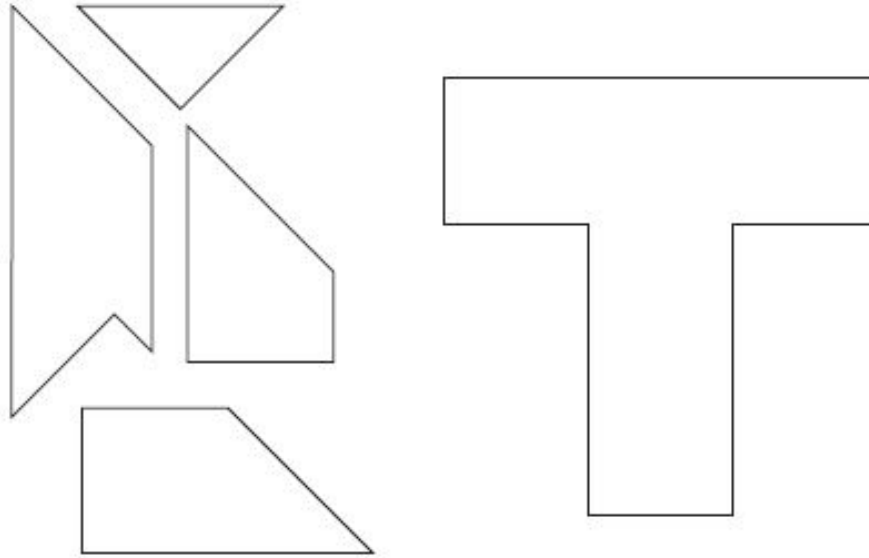
